

University Admission Requirements 2008

with updates for the new mathematics curriculum

Exigences d'admission universitaire 2008

y compris les mises à jour du nouveau curriculum de mathématiques

Within the past year, the Ontario government has revised the secondary school mathematics curriculum, and therefore the prerequisites for many university programs will change for those students beginning university studies in fall 2008. These curriculum changes have compelled Ontario's universities to review and update all of their admission requirements for 2008. The result of this update is the coordinated, advanced release of all admission requirements, including the new math requirements, which will assist university-bound students in planning their Grade 12 course selections accordingly.

The following charts provide a listing of the requirements for each university. The first column lists the OUAC program code, followed by the university program name. The second column lists the prerequisites required for admission to each program, effective September 2008. If you have any questions, please consult the appropriate university calendar, admissions handbook, or Admissions or Liaison Office.

Au cours de la dernière année, le gouvernement de l'Ontario a révisé le curriculum de mathématiques du niveau secondaire; par conséquent, les préalables de nombreux programmes universitaires seront modifiés dans le cas des étudiants qui amorceront leurs études universitaires en automne 2008. De tels changements ont contraint les universités ontariennes à effectuer la revue et la mise à jour de toutes leurs exigences d'admission pour 2008. Il résulte d'une telle mise à jour le lancement coordonné et hâtif de toutes les exigences d'admission, y compris les nouvelles exigences en matière de mathématiques; ceci permettra, par le fait même, aux élèves se dirigeant vers des études universitaires de planifier en conséquence leurs cours de 12^e année.

Les tableaux qui suivent énumèrent les exigences de chaque université. La première colonne affiche le code OUAC du programme, suivi du nom du programme universitaire en question. La deuxième colonne affiche les préalables nécessaires aux fins d'admission pour chaque programme, à compter de septembre 2008. Si vous avez des questions, veuillez s.v.p. consulter l'annuaire ou le guide d'admission de l'université de votre choix, ou communiquer avec son Service d'admission ou de liaison.

Special Notes:

1. Math Course Requirements:

Students interested in university programs that require Grade 12 mathematics courses should be aware that, under Ministry of Education guidelines, MHF4U is a prerequisite or corequisite of MCV4U. This means that MHF4U must be taken before or, depending on your secondary school course scheduling rules, at the same time as MCV4U. Some university programs require both of these mathematics courses. However, you will also see that, in some cases, the requirement may be stated as MCV4U and one other math course.

Note: Those who plan to take MCV4U to meet university requirements should keep in mind that MHF4U must be taken concurrently with or precede MCV4U to satisfy course requirements specified by the Ministry of Education. If you have questions about these requirements you should consult with your guidance counsellor.

2. Admission Averages:

Please note that universities have different admission average calculation methodologies. For example, some universities specify that required courses be included in the average, while others only consider the best six 4U or 4M level courses. Applicants should consult individual university admissions publications, websites or eINFO, at www.electronicinfo.ca, for specific information about admission average calculation.

3. Old Versus New Mathematics Curriculum:

Students who will present mathematics courses from both the old and new mathematics curriculum should consult the universities of interest directly regarding the completion of admission requirements.

Notes Spéciales :

1. Exigences de mathématiques :

*Les élèves souhaitant faire demande à un programme universitaire qui exige la réussite de cours de mathématiques de 12^e année doivent savoir que, en vertu des lignes directrices du ministère de l'Éducation, le cours MHF4U est préalable ou associé au cours MCV4U. Par conséquent, le cours MHF4U doit être suivi préalablement ou simultanément au cours MCV4U, tout dépendant des règles d'établissement des horaires de votre école secondaire. Certains programmes universitaires exigent la réussite de ces deux cours de mathématiques. Toutefois, vous remarquerez également que, dans certains cas, l'exigence peut être indiquée comme étant le MCV4U et un autre cours de maths. **Note :** Celles et ceux qui comptent suivre le cours MCV4U dans le but de satisfaire aux exigences d'une université doivent suivre le cours MHF4U – préalablement ou simultanément –, afin de satisfaire aux exigences du ministère de l'Éducation. Si vous avez des questions au sujet des exigences susmentionnées, veuillez consulter votre conseillère ou conseiller en orientation.*

2. Moyennes d'admission :

Veillez noter que les méthodes de calcul des moyennes d'admission diffèrent d'une université à l'autre. Par exemple, certaines universités précisent que certains cours doivent être inclus dans la moyenne, alors que d'autres n'utilisent que les six meilleurs cours 4U ou 4M dans le calcul de la moyenne. Pour en savoir davantage sur le calcul des moyennes d'admission, nous conseillons aux candidates et candidats de consulter les publications portant sur l'admission ou les sites Web des universités de leur choix, ou le site eINFO (www.infoelectronique.ca).

3. Ancien et nouveau curriculum de mathématiques :

Dans le cas d'élèves ayant suivi des cours de mathématiques de l'ancien et du nouveau curriculum, ils doivent communiquer directement avec l'université ou les universités de leur choix, quant aux programmes ayant des cours de mathématiques comme exigences d'admission.
