

## WHAT IS E-LEARNING

---

E-Learning is the delivery of a learning, training or education program by electronic means. eLearning involves the use of a computer or electronic device to provide training, educational or learning material.

Students will experience a new way to use technology while earning a high school credit. Students will have access to a variety of tools that will make student part of a virtual classroom. There is technology that will allow students to work collaboratively with their peers to have thoughtful discussions and debates, and learn from each other. In order to make this work effectively, it is important that you learn about the tools and use them on a regular basis as directed by your teacher.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

---

The courses meet all the Ministry course expectations, but there is much more independent learning on the part of the student.

There are many tools; and the student will learn about these tools during the mandatory orientation which occurs after the student registers for an on-line course.

A teacher is assigned to each course; the teacher may be in a different school location or even located at a different school board in Ontario.

The teacher is there to help and support the student with any course related questions the student may have, and will be assessing and evaluating the student's progress throughout the course.
