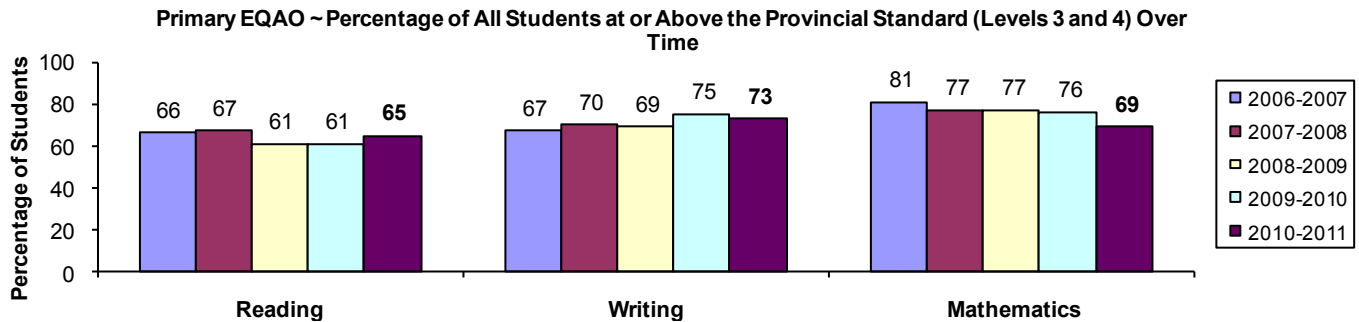


Highlights of EQAO Results (2010-2011)

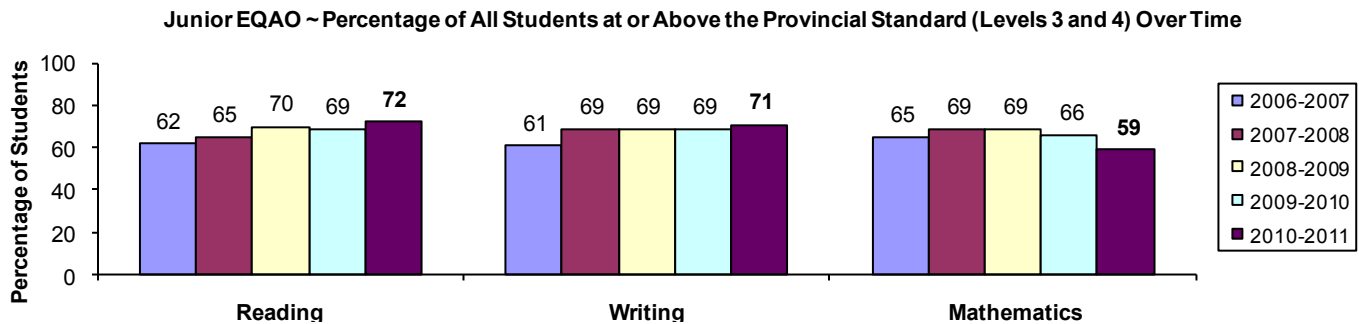
Assessment of Reading, Writing and Mathematics, Primary Division (Grades 1—3)

- 1 540 Grade 3 students wrote the 2010-2011 assessment.
- The assessment measures the reading, writing and mathematics skills *The Ontario Curriculum* expects students to have learned by the end of Grade 3.



Assessment of Reading, Writing and Mathematics, Junior Division (Grades 4—6)

- 1 710 Grade 6 students wrote the 2010-2011 assessment.
- The assessment measures the reading, writing and mathematics skills *The Ontario Curriculum* expects students to have learned by the end of Grade 6.



Grade 9 Assessment Mathematics

- 1 249 students in the academic programs and 618 students in applied programs wrote the 2010-2011 assessment.
- This assessment measures the mathematics skills *The Ontario Curriculum* expects students to have learned by the end of Grade 9. Separate versions of the assessment are administered to students in the academic and the applied courses.
