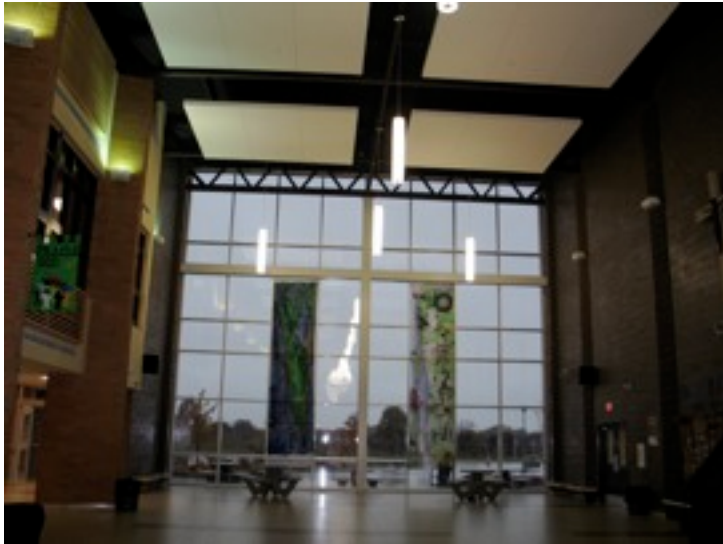


Go with the Flow
The Big Draw on the Rivers and Lakes of Essex County Ontario
St. Anne's High School
Lakeshore, Ontario

For three weeks grade 12 students at St. Anne's High School in Lakeshore gathered information on local waters and worked on site drawings at Point Pelee National Park. They then created two 20 foot panels, one depicting Point Pelee and the other the Detroit River.



Recognizing that we need to care for the waters that have been given to us by God, the work was designed to illustrate the situation of our local waters from an ecological point of view. These pieces are installed on the windows in the atrium at St. Anne's High School. We were the only Canadian group involved in the international "Big Draw 2009"
