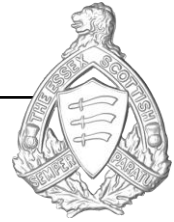

In 2006, a memorial was installed and dedicated in Dieppe, France where The Essex Scottish Regiment first landed as part of the ill-fated raid known as OPERATION JUBILEE. Now plans are underway on the Dieppe Memorial Project II. The monument will be a duplicate of the one erected in France and will stand in a central location in Dieppe Gardens on Windsor's waterfront. It will serve to honour our Regimental fallen and to assist those who may never have an opportunity to visit the sister monument in France. The project, entitled “A Child Shall Lead the Way” will support the efforts of local school children in raising the funds needed to construct and install the new Windsor monument.
