#### SYNOPSIS:

This report has been prepared to provide information on the 2020-21 Budget Consultation Survey results.

#### **BACKGROUND COMMENTS:**

The Board is committed to ensuring that sufficient communication and consultation with the community exists regarding 2020-21 budget development. The community has been invited to provide input at an early stage of budget development through a formal budget consultation survey. The intent of the survey is to inform the Board's budget development and assist in formulating and affirming Board priorities as the Board works to promote excellence in education within a Faith-centered learning environment.

The Board utilized School Messenger to perform a phone survey of all student families. In addition, the on-line survey tool was available to all stakeholders on the Board's website.

Availability of the on-line survey was advertised in the Windsor Star, and communicated formally to certain stakeholders including Principals and Vice-Principals, the Parent Involvement Committee, the Special Education Advisory Committee, the French Immersion Advisory Committee, the Indigenous Education Advisory Committee, the Audit Committee, the Equity & Inclusiveness Committee, Catholic School Advisory Councils, employee groups (OECTA, Unifor, CUPE, Non-Union), the Student Senate, and employees via the internal email system and Google Communities.

In addition, the Director of Education formally communicated to the Pastoral Team informing them of the survey and requesting their assistance in notifying their parish communities of the opportunity to provide input.

As of the original March 6, 2020 submission deadline, 2,049 survey responses were received. By comparison, 1,299 survey responses were received for the 2019-20 Budget Consultation Survey. Responses were received from stakeholder groups as follows:

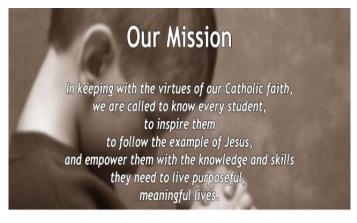


# 2020-21 Budget Consultation Survey Overview

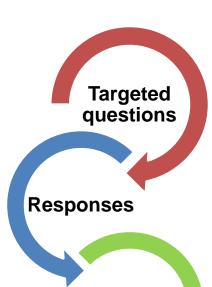

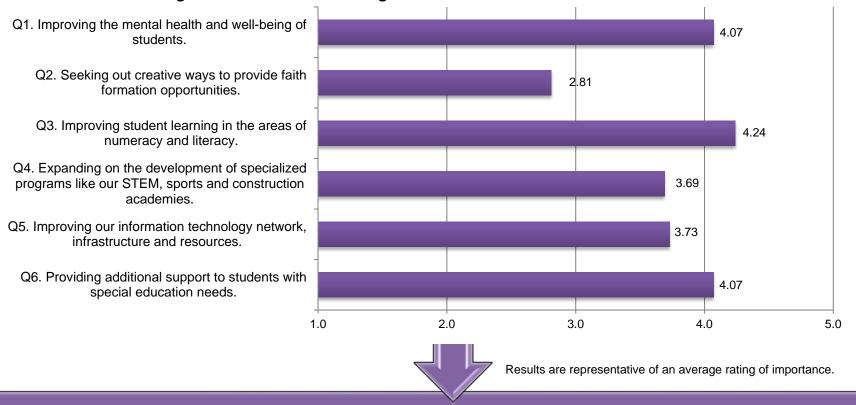

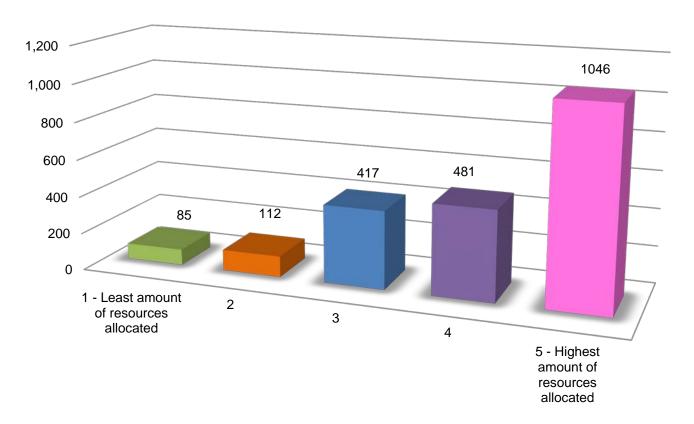

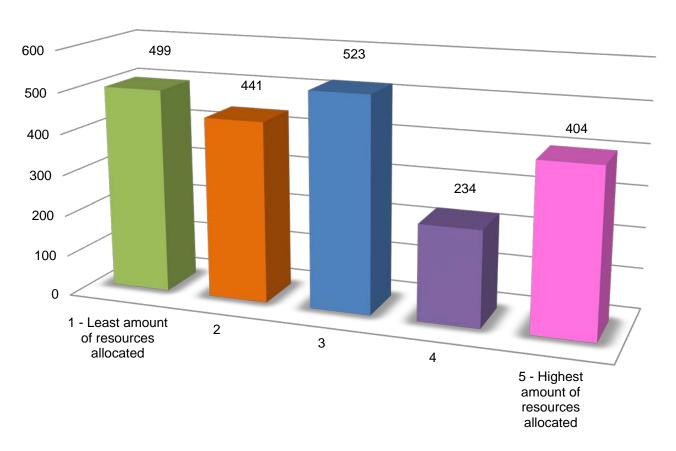

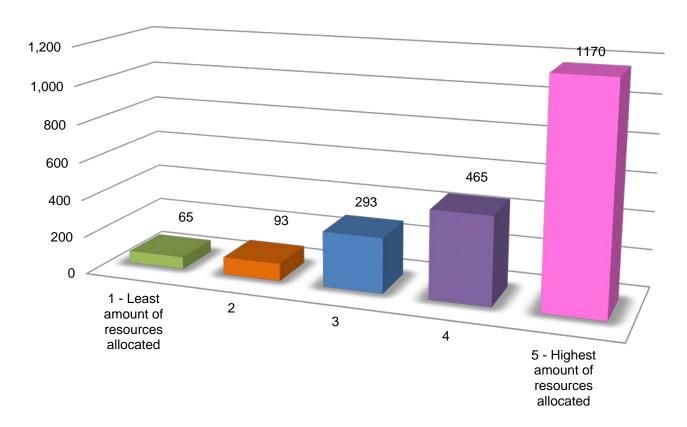

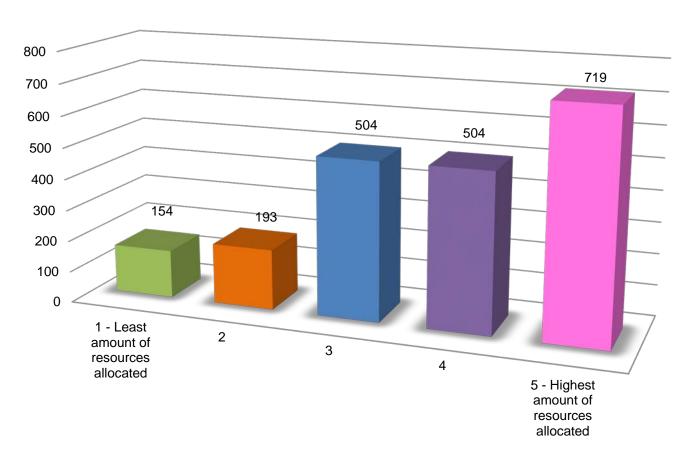

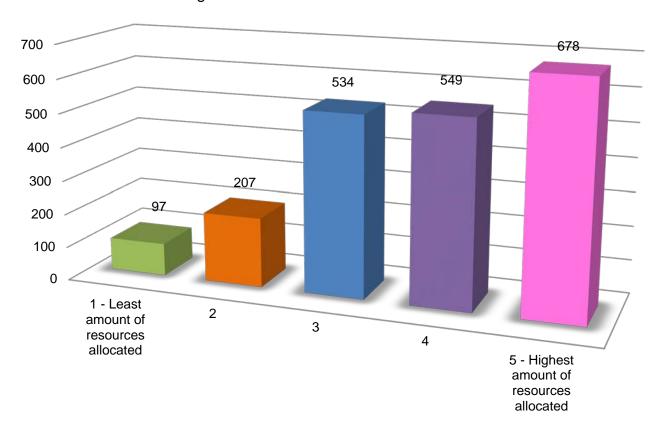

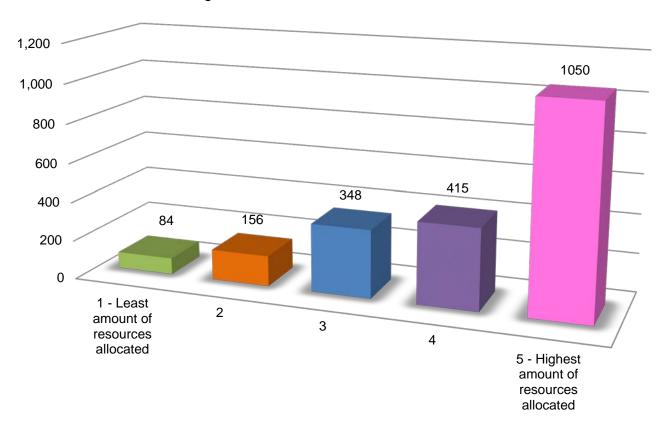

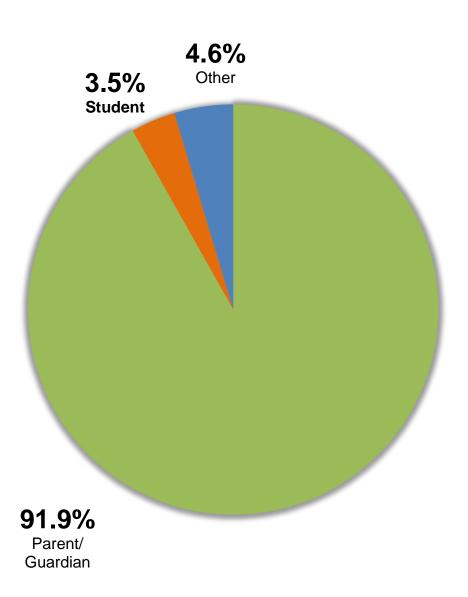
